- Susu:** This teaching leaflet is sent to 1100 who've completed all our correspondence lessons but still want to receive teaching. Most want this because they're unable to attend a Church. Some have become Christians. Others are continuing to seek God. As well, we've found the group covers a very wide age range. So this month we'll start doing 4 versions of Susu, for four age groups - with different Team members responsible for each age group.

- Learning to trust:** This month, as a Team, we're looking at ways we can especially encourage children who face opposition, and how we can help them trust God for help in miraculous ways when it seems their families are totally against them studying with us. In Thai culture children are taught they can trust no one except themselves. Please pray God's wisdom and creativity for ways that we can help children learn to trust Him to do what seems impossible.

Correspondence program: Please continue to pray for each Team member writing to children. God is using them to bring His truth to these children and they know they need His anointing and wisdom for this. We do thank God for letters like these that show what He is doing.
