Flooding continues to be very bad in Thailand this year and since July the death toll from the nationwide flooding is now 206 people. In many areas postal services are totally disrupted and that means a lot of lessons have gone missing. Please pray also for children studying with us who live in flooded areas - for God's protection for them and their families. Also pray for Art and his wife and 3 children. Their home is near a canal and has had some flooding already.
